EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS TIP -- WATER 1 gallon minimum/person/day for a 4 day supply. Appropriate containers should be various sizes & include polyethylene-based plastic marked #1, 2 or 4 (not milk jugs). A water filter/purifier is also good for natural water supplies.
