The Good Samaritan, a symbol of our Savior, promises to return, this time in majesty and glory."

As we watch and listen to the spirit, God will bless us in our efforts to care for those in need and to lift one another's burdens is my testimony in the name of Jesus Christ, amen.

FROM THE STAKE

Our spring Weber River Recreation Camp cleanup/prep work project is scheduled for Saturday May 15th from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM weather permitting. We want to avoid Memorial Day weekend and give us an option for rescheduling for either May 22nd or early June if needed. We would like to invite each participating stake to have at least 5 people available to assist in the work.

Some of the projects include moving equipment from storage out to the pavilion; clearing brush and dead fall/grooming trails and tent sites; placing sand in tent sites; placing gravel on trails; sealing wood trim on pavilion and amphitheater seats; prep work for volleyball court and possibly horseshoe pits and lower parking lot.

Justice League Vaccination Clinic—On May 8th, from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm, the Refugee Justice League, in cooperation with the Salt Lake County Health Department, will sponsor a vaccination clinic at the Justice League offices located at 415 East 3900 South in South Salt Lake. The Refugee Justice League is a non-profit refugee service organization.

Although the refugee response has been significant, a limited amount of vaccinations will be available for non-refugees. If there are members of your ward who have had difficulty getting vaccinations, this may be a convenient opportunity for them to be vaccinated.

The available vaccination time slots are not unlimited and appointments will be scheduled on a first come, first serve basis. All normal age and health restrictions will apply. Those who receive their first vaccination on May 8th will be scheduled for their second vaccination at the Refugee Justice League on June 5th.

Since the availability of vaccines, in addition to masks and social distancing, we are thrilled to see the dramatic decrease in Covid cases and anticipate a continued downward trend.
