Missionary Preparation:

Welfare Square Cannery (4) Paid Positions:

Welfare Square Cannery has 4 **On-Call Production Technician Labor** positions available, effective January 4, 2021. These are paid positions.

General assignments are: Working on packaging lines, warehouse activities, cleaning and sanitizing equipment and the facility, and all other general tasks assigned by the Supervisor.

Shifts:

2 positions available 6:00 – 11:00 AM Monday – Friday

2 positions available 1:00 – 6:00 PM Monday – Friday

The positions are ideal for individuals (male or female) preparing to serve missions, or returning from missions, or who may be attending school.

We are seeking individuals who can commit to serve for at least 3-months. All applicants must be temple recommend worthy.

Welfare Square Cannery (4) Volunteer Positions:

The following volunteer positions are available beginning January 4th 2021.

1. **Assistant Volunteer Coordinator(s) (individual or a couple):** helps the Volunteer Coordinator manage all volunteers, missionaries, service missionaries, and contacts stakes via email and phone. Shift is negotiable between these hours Monday – Friday, 630A-5P.
2. **Receptionist Volunteer(s) (individual or a couple):** welcomes all volunteers with a warm, friendly smile, signs them in, and directs them to the orientation and/or preparation room; light office work Shift is negotiable between these hours Monday – Friday, 630A-5P.
3. **Orientation Presenter(s) (individual or a couple):** present the orientation in a warm, friendly manner. Help volunteers prepare to enter the warehouse and production area

(wash hands, aprons, gloves, and hair nets). Shift is negotiable between these hours Monday – Friday, 630A-5P.

4. **Warehouse and Production workers (individuals or couples):** all aspects of the cannery which include helping in production, boxing, forklift driving, labeling, etc. Shift is negotiable between these hours Monday – Friday, 630A-6P.

Requirements from Welfare Square: "Minimum age is 16, no age cap. Individuals must be kind, friendly, and work with a purpose of service. We are a team working to provide to those in need. Our volunteers need to know each of us are working on the front line of feeding the hungry. All who enter the cannery are welcome! Volunteers in the office may work with confidential information and must respect the position as one of responsibility."
